Slips, Trips, falls	Possible serious	All participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Effective group management at all times. ● Good briefing before start of activity, continues monitoring throughout activity. ● Appropriate footwear. ● Spotting if necessary. ● Suitable entry to venue. 	Low
Instructors error	Unlikely serious	All participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● All instructors will hold the appropriate qualifications (spa) or above and had some experience with the activity. ● All instructors will hold up to date first aid certificate and carry first aid kit and shelter.
